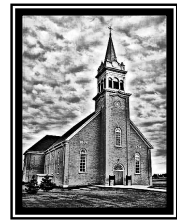

Message from Angela Bowman sent March 3rd – Re: Vocations Prayer Calendars:

Blessings in Christ, As you may already be aware, prayer calendars have been created with the intention to help all the Baptized be consistent in praying for the sanctification of those who have already entered the priestly or religious life, for permanent deacons, for seminarians; and also, for an increase in vocations to the priesthood and religious life. This will allow you to distribute the calendars to your parishioners through printed copies inserted in parish bulletins and on your parish webpages.
