From the Office of the Archbishop: The government of Canada has made a decision requiring those who apply for grants through the Summer Jobs Grant Program to sign an "attestation" saying that they support the government's position that there is a right to an abortion in Canada. All parishes in our Archdiocese are encouraged to write to our Federal MP's protesting against this.
