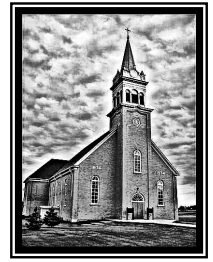

**From the Office of the Archbishop:** The government of Canada has made a decision requiring those who apply for grants through the Summer Jobs Grant Program to sign an "attestation" saying that they support the government's position that there is a right to an abortion in Canada. A letter has been prepared, copies of which are available at the church entrance for you to address and sign.
