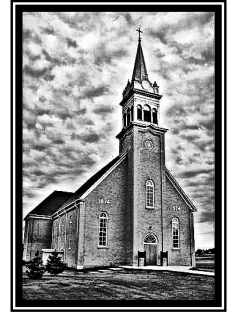

Updates to COVID-19 Restrictions

Effective March 1st, 2022, there are no longer any capacity restrictions on indoor gatherings. (The protocols on wearing masks in indoor places will continue until March 15th.)

Other changes now in effect include:

- Celebrations of First Communion, Confirmation, Baptism, Reconciliation, Anointing of the sick, marriages and funerals return to normal with no capacity restrictions;
- The sign of peace will continue to be expressed with a head bow towards others;
- Communion processions can return without physical distancing;
- The distribution of Communion can return to pre-pandemic practice with the exception that the communion cup will not be offered;
- Holy Water fonts may be filled and used.
