## **Updates to COVID-19 Restrictions**

Effective March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, there are no longer any capacity restrictions on indoor gatherings. (The protocols on wearing masks in indoor places will continue until March 15<sup>th</sup>.)

Other changes now in effect include:

- Celebrations of First Communion, Confirmation, Baptism, Reconciliation, Anointing of the sick, marriages and funerals return to normal with no capacity restrictions;
- The sign of peace will continue to be expressed with a head bow towards others;
- Communion processions can return without physical distancing;
- The distribution of Communion can return to pre-pandemic practice with the exception that the communion cup will not be offered;
- Holy Water fonts may be filled and used.
