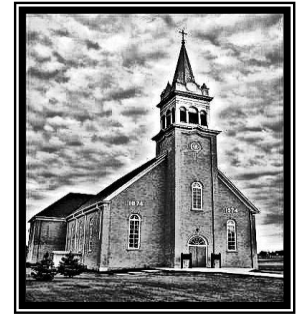

MEMORANDUM

To: All Parishes

Date: March 6, 2015

The major liturgical celebration of our Jubilee Year will take place on Sunday, May 3, 2015 at the MTS Centre. It is important that we use this celebration to generously respond to the blessings we have and continue to receive from God.

The logistics of taking a collection at the MTS Mass is somewhat problematic. Therefore I am requesting that all Parishes in the Archdiocese take up a second collection at Masses on the two Sundays prior to our celebration, that is April 19 and 26. Envelopes will be provided for this collection.

The entire collection will be donated to "Returning to Spirit" and their important work of reconciliation between Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people.

More information, including bulletin announcements and details on the remittance of the collection to the Catholic Centre will follow.

The proceeds of the Archdiocesan wide collection will be symbolically presented at our Jubilee Mass on May 3.
