St. Eustache Lighting Project

Have you noticed that the lights on the cross in the sanctuary now light up? The Committee's goal is to convert all the church lights to LED. As of now, the "under the balcony lights" have all been changed as well as the sanctuary pillar lights. The remaining halogen pillar lights need to be converted as well, at a cost of \$90.00 each (includes tax).

Thank you to families who have donated, also to Grant and committee who initiated the project. However, we still have 10 halogen fixtures to replace. We know these LED lights consume less power and therefore decrease power costs.
