THE MONTH OF OUR LADY

Referring to the month of May, Our Lady said:

"May this month be for you the month of the rosary and reading your Bible..."

Reflection: The month of May means that spring is here, and all of nature seems to rejoice: budding flowers and trees, green grass and sunshine, usher in a season of soft colours and new life.

This is Mary's month, of May crownings, processions, the rosary and, as she says today, a time for reading sacred scripture.

As Catholics, we are aware that the Bible is the inspired word of God, that his presence and truth are found within its pages. In somewhat the same way, nature reveals the image and beauty of God. St. Paul writes, "Since the creation of the world, invisible realities, God's eternal power and divinity, have become visible, recognized through the things he has made" (*Rom 1:20*)

You visit the earth and water it, you greatly enrich it; the river of God is full of water; you provide the people with grain, for so you have prepared it. You water its furrows abundantly, settling its ridges, softening it with showers, and blessing its growth. The pastures of the wilderness overflow, the hills gird themselves with joy, the meadows clothe themselves with flocks, the valleys deck themselves with grain. They shout and sing together for joy. (*Psalm 65: 9-10, 12-13*)
