The Archdiocese of Winnipeg Synod Secretariat is pleased to announce that the Second Phase of preparations for the Synod of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg is nearing completion.

The nine Focus Commissions met several times over the last few months to generate draft reports for consideration and response from any and all of the faithful of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. Parishioners are invited to read any or all of the reports listed below and are also encouraged to discuss the various themes with church groups, family and friends and may consider making a joint response.

The responses that are received will be returned to each of the nine Focus Commissions and will become part of each of the Focus Commissions' final reports that will form the basis for the Synod's next phase, the General Sessions.
