MEMORANDUM from Archbishop Richard Gagnon

Date: June 20, 2017

Re: Consecration of Canada to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Earlier this year the Executive Council of the CCCB approved a proposal to consecrate Canada to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the occasion of the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Confederation.

It was determined that each Bishop in his diocese would pray the Prayer of Consecration on Saturday, July 1, 2017 or the following day July 2, 2017. It is my intention to lead this consecration at St. Mary's Cathedral on Sunday, July 2, 2017 at the 11:30 Mass.

I am inviting all Pastors and Administrators to join in this celebration by consecrating your Parish/Mission(s) to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as part of celebrating this 150<sup>th</sup> birthday of Canada.

I would ask that the Prayer of Consecration be prayed after the Sunday Homily on July 1 - 2, 2017. The consecration ends with a Litany for Canada.
