Second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

The second World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated on Sunday, July 24, 2022. As described in his official message, Pope Francis invites everyone to celebrate this day so that we ensure "no one lives this day in loneliness." The theme chosen by the Holy Father for the occasion is "In old age, they will still bear fruit" (Ps 92:15).

It was announced that the Apostolic Penitentiary has granted the **Plenary Indulgence** to all the elderly who participate in the World Day liturgies, and to all those who in the days immediately preceding or following World Day visit an elderly person who is alone. The visit, in fact, writes Pope Francis in his message for World Day, "is a work of mercy in our time!"

Message from Archbishop Richard Gagnon re: Trip to Edmonton for Papal Visit

The Archdiocese of Winnipeg is sponsoring a chartered bus of Indigenous Elders who attended Residential Schools in our communities to attend the Papal Visit in Edmonton. Archbishop Gagnon, along with a small planning committee, will accompany them.

The group departs on Saturday, July 23rd in the afternoon and will go to Edmonton. They will attend the meeting with indigenous peoples at the former Ermineskin Residential School in Maskwacis, Alberta, on Monday, July 25th. On Tuesday, July 26th, they will attend Holy Mass at Commonwealth Stadium and then the Pilgrimage to the site of Lac Ste. Anne and Liturgy of the Word. They will depart Wednesday, July 27th and return to Winnipeg on Thursday, July 28th.

Please remember in your prayers this important pilgrimage that is making its way across the country for the Papal Visit. Let us pray that much good fruit will come from Pope Francis' visit and that this will be a significant step towards truth, healing, and reconciliation.
