The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

"The proper time for receiving the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick has certainly arrived when the believer begins to be in danger of death because of illness or old age. Each time a Christian falls seriously ill, he may receive the Anointing of the Sick, and also when, after he has received it, the illness worsens. Only priests (presbyters and bishops) can give the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, using oil blessed by the bishop, or if necessary by the celebrating presbyter himself."
(Catechism of the Catholic Church No 1528 - 1530)
