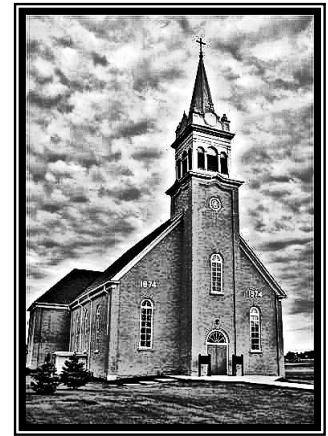

Re: Public Presentation on Protecting Minors from Sexual Abuse

Next month Sr. Nuala Kenny will be in the Archdiocese to speak to the clergy on the dynamics of Clergy Sexual Abuse and the need for personal and ecclesial transformation.

Sr. Nuala Kenny is an acknowledged expert on the pathology of Clergy Sexual abuse and was a consultant to the recently released document "Protecting Minors from Sexual Abuse: A Call to the Catholic Faithful in Canada for Healing, Reconciliation and Transformation" from the CCCB.

Since Sr. Nuala will be in the Archdiocese it was thought wise to invite her to give two public sessions for all the faithful of our local church. These public sessions will take place in Brandon and Winnipeg.

The session, "Healing the Church from Clergy Sexual Abuse: A Call to the Catholic Faithful" will be held on Wednesday, October 9 at 7:00 pm at St. Augustine's Parish in Brandon and on Thursday, October 10 at 7:00 pm at Petrus Hall in Winnipeg. The sessions will be for approximately 90 minutes.

I am asking all parishes to advertise these sessions in their parish bulletins and invite parishioners to attend. In addition I am asking all Pastors and Parish Administrators to ensure that members of their Parish Pastoral Councils and Pastoral Leadership attend the session.
