To honour the completion of the ten-year pastoral plan "Building a Church of Communion", clergy, religious andlay faithful from the parishes of the North, Central and South Winnipeg deaneries will gather on **Thursday evening, October 16, 2014 at St. Paul the Apostle Church, 2400 Portage Avenue, Winnipeg.** Our interdeanery gathering begins with the celebration of the **Eucharist at 7:30 p.m.**, presided by Archbishop Richard Gagnon, to be followed by a reception in the parish hall. In addition to refreshments provided by the parishes of the deaneries, the reception will feature a pictorial reflection of experiences in our parishes over the past ten years and Tom Denton of Hospitality House will speak on some of our efforts throughout the Archdiocese to welcome refugees to Canada.
