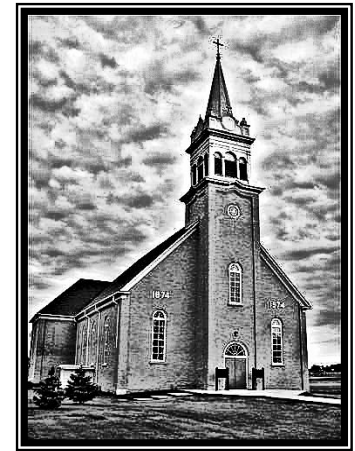

Please plan on attending to honour our Canadian military and service personnel past and present for sacrifices made on our behalf.


There will be refreshments served after the ceremony at the St. Eustache Cartier Hall.
